**Code of Ethics:** Each class of membership shall follow PWR's code of ethics as described:

- 1) Practice integrity, honesty, and truthfulness.

- 4) Inspire others through their own sense of dedication and high purpose.
- 5) Improve their professional knowledge and skills.
- 6) Demonstrate concern for the interests and well being of individuals.
- 7) Value the privacy, freedom of choice and interests of others.
- 8) Foster cultural diversity and treat all people with dignity and respect.
- 9) Affirm, through personal giving, a commitment to philanthropy and its role in society.
- 10) Any communications regarding PWR are to be authorized by PWR's Board of Directors.
- 11) Unauthorized communications, including interviews, editorials, letters or any other verbal or written communication is expressly prohibited without prior authorization.
- 12) Adhere to the spirit as well as the letter of all applicable laws and regulations.
- 13) Avoid even the appearance of any criminal offense or professional misconduct.
- 14) Support PWR both internally and externally.
- 15) Not cause or bring negative publicity to PWR.
- 16) Bring credit to the fundraising profession by their public demeanor.
- 17) Encourage colleagues to embrace and practice these ethical principles and standards of professional practice.
